The Balfour Cemetery is located on the paved access road to the Balfour Golf Course. A small dirt road leaving to the right of the paved road will take you to this small cemetery. There are many old burials here, and the cemetery is still being used to date with recent cleanup evident around the periphery. A small works shed is located near the gate but is in disrepair.

The cemetery was recorded in 4 blocks:

- A – runs along the edge of the paved road
- B – runs along the edge of the service road for the golf course
- C – larger center block in approximately 4 sections, 1,2,3,4
- D – newer section, divided from C by a walkway
